

ICAR- CCRI signs MoU with Sahyadri Farms for production of quality planting material of citrus

In order to boost the production of quality nursery planting materials of citrus, ICAR-Central Citrus Research Institute (ICAR-CCRI) signed one Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Nashik based M/s.
